STEP 6 - REFLECT

- Submit Final Report

Steps 5 and 6 must be completed by the time a girl reaches age 14 or before she starts the 10th grade.

A girl must be 12 or going into 7th grade to start Steps 5 and 6.

STEP 4 - CREATE - Girl Scout Silver 4 B's Challenge

- Become - set goals for self-improvement
- Belong - Do STUDIO 2B Focus Book: "Looking in, Reaching Out"
- Believe - Focus on a community issue
- Build - Focus on a solution



STEP 2 - LEAD

Girl Scout Silver Leadership Award

- Earn 3 IP's related to parts of the GS Promise and Law
- Do STUDIO 2B Focus Book: "uniquely ME! The Real Deal"
- Take action: spend 15 hours in a leadership role



STEP 3 - NETWORK

Girl Scout Silver Career Award

- Who's out there?
- Earn "Your Own Business IP"



Use the Girl Scout Silver Award workbook to keep, record and journal Steps 2-5. Good record keeping will help you evaluate in Step 6.

STEP 1 - ORGANIZE

- Read "Go For It" Girl Scout Silver Award STUDIO 2B insert and attend a council sponsored Girl Scout Silver Award Workshop
- Meet with troop advisor (your leader) and develop a timeline for Steps 2-4, include some thinking about where Step 5 might fit on your timeline
- Make an agreement with troop advisor

A girl must be 11 or going into the 6th grade to work on Steps 1-4 of the Girl Scout Silver Award.
